If you are using a SMART Board in your classroom, you will have SMART Notebook software installed on the connected computer. SMART Notebook allows you to open and view the SMART Notebook lessons provided on this USB stick.

These lessons were developed in version 10.7 of the software and it is advised you update to the latest version. Please see your IT administrator regarding this. SMART Notebook and other SMART applications can be downloaded from <http://smarttech.com/au/Support/Browse+Support/Download+Software>
